

The Wolf Clan

Welcome to the Wolf Clan, where we prepare for our Winter work just as the wolves get ready for the time when they will travel to the extreme edges of their range looking for what they need in order to survive.

Twilight Covening is unique in allowing us to begin specific focused pieces of work within a ritual magickal context. Twilight Covening is not only your clan experience but it is an entire framework that allows you to expand your magical tools by using the lens of a specific clans work.

In preparation for the work in this clan, we ask that you look within to find a word that embodies and will help you manifest the work you need to do this winter. We also ask that you arrive as early as possible to get unpacked in the clan sleeping/sacred space. We will be meeting before the opening circle to plan the Midnight Attunement on Friday night, which we will facilitate together after the Community Releasing Fire. Don't forget to bring a burnable object to symbolically release whatever blocks you from your winter work.

The clan sleeping space will also be our clan cabin, so bring items of particular resonance for you and to the Wolf to put on a communal altar in that space. You can also bring Wolf items for the clan table in the dining room. While you are packing your wolf items, remember to bring plenty of warm clothing (layers) and bedding, as well as inclement weather gear (just in case), a blindfold and a soup vegetable.

Saturday night will be an all night vigil holding the edges of the camp to look for both your separateness and your connection to the Community on the boundary of here and not here. There will be sleeping time Sunday morning in preparation for the Twilight Covening Main Ritual Sunday Night.

Though we will be looking at aggression, a wolf is not that two dimensional. We will also look at affection, pack loyalty, individuality, energy exchange, and communal altered states.
